



WELCOMING AN ANIMAL INTO YOUR CLASSROOM

In the event that an animal accompanies a Humane Educator into a classroom, there are a few guidelines that need to be followed.

- Teachers or staff requesting a presentation must inform school administration that an animal is to be brought in. Humane Educators must be informed in advance that an animal has been allowed.
- The Los Angeles Unified School District requires a parent permission slip for each student attending the presentation. Please check with your school districts for any visiting animal requirements.
- Students must remain in their seats when an animal enters the room.
- Students should not touch the animals unless directed to do so.
- No one should call a dog to their desk. Dogs need to be free of distraction.
- Teasing or harassing the animal will not be tolerated.

Teachers, please inform you students of these rules before our visit. Remember, animals are living creatures that deserve respect. Following these guidelines will ensure that our teaching animal will have a pleasant experience.
